
Paid directly to the training provider by the Education and Skills Funding Agency (ESFA).



If you're an employer with a wage bill over £3 million each year your funding will be paid directly to the training provider from your apprenticeship levy, and you will only have to pay the 5% co-funding if you have exhausted all of your levy funds.

Level 3 Paralegal Law Apprenticeship Overview

This Level 3 Paralegal qualification and Law Apprenticeship is a nationally recognised qualification for those looking to become a paralegal and those with some paralegal experience who are looking to progress their career in the legal sector. In this apprenticeship you'll receive the highest standard of training that combines the academic and practical skills required to work within the legal sector. Upon completion of this course candidates will become a licensed paralegal. You will also be awarded a Level 3 in Paralegal training (equivalent to A-level in Law).

This apprenticeship provides exemptions for entrance onto the Solicitor Apprentice standard. Providing options for further career progression.

Employers will benefit from talent retention, better qualified support staff and upon completion of this course each paralegal will be an eligible fee earner. As those working in a law firm who have the Level 3 Paralegal Diploma can charge fee-earning at grade D of the Law Society's Guideline Hourly Rates.

Career Progression

As a recognised Level 3 course this route is designed with the SRA's new Solicitor Qualifying Exam (SQE) in mind. Upon completion of this, candidates will be eligible to progress to Datalaw's Level 7 Solicitor Apprenticeship.



How is it funded?

The ESFA have set aside government funding in the form of the apprenticeship levy to train professionals in work to increase talent acquisition and career progression.

This funding is available to all law firms in England and as a registered provider Datalaw can take advantage of this funding on your firm's behalf to subsidise the cost of this qualification.



What is Included?

- Level 3 Apprenticeship (foundation year or a-level equivalent)
- Become a licensed paralegal
- Occupational certification for all modules undertaken
- 1-2-1 coaching
- Online classroom sessions
- 100s of hours of online learning resources



What is the cost?

Just £550 +VAT

The full cost of this qualification is £11,000. If co-funded your firm will pay a 5% contribution, which is £550+VAT, and the ESFA will fund the rest. This is more cost effective than purchasing a diploma.

Duration

The duration of this qualification will depend on the optional legal modules you choose, the number of hours you work per week and your prior legal learning/experience. However, on average this apprenticeship takes 13 months to complete.

Assessments

Throughout this apprenticeship you will undertake written assignments alongside building a portfolio of occupational and academic evidence of work. Nearing the end of this apprenticeship you will participate in a gateway meeting with your employer and coach to confirm you have met the required level to complete the apprenticeship. Once ready, you will be entered for your end point assessment and final grading. The end point assessment is a two part assessment. Part 1 consisting of two written assessments and Part 2 consisting of a competency based interview, where you will be asked questions regarding your portfolio of work. The Paralegal Apprenticeship is graded Fail, Pass, or Distinction and the overall grade for the EPA is based on your achievements across both the components.
